## Tuesday, January 2410 Advocacy for Native Americans, Vicki Karlson

Vicki Karlson is a graduate of Rockford High School who started her career at Michigan Bell in her senior year. She retired early in 1994 after her son's graduation from college. During her retirement, she has helped her husband with computer applications for his business, worked for a financial manager and helped run a beauty salon.

Then, volunteering became very important. First, she volunteered at the Fredrick Meijer Gardens. She explained, "Being involved in the first 10 years was very exciting. Meeting the sculptors, and welcoming the members to special events were some of my favorite times."

Things changed for Vicki in 2004 when she joined a volunteer group from her church on a mission trip to Pine Ridge Reservation in South Dakota. The volunteers worked with the local Lakota people to help improve their quality of life on the reservation, such as by doing home repairs. Volunteers learned the Lakota culture through their interaction with the Lakota people. After three years of volunteering in the office and kitchen, she became the Volunteer-Coordinator. She retired from that position in 2011, but continued with a Women's Project of her own until 2015. She now continues to visit and advocates for all Native People.
