Lions Miracle Field

About two years ago, plans were announced to build a championship-caliber baseball/softball complex in West Michigan. The complex will ultimately have 12 fields, including a West Michigan Miracle League field for individuals with disabilities. The Opening Day is scheduled for Saturday, September 21 at 12:00 pm at the Nate Hurwitz Field, located at 3300 10 Mile Road, Rockford, Michigan 49341 (just east of US-131). The West Michigan Miracle League is planning a ceremony, player parade and exhibition innings for Opening Day.

Last spring, the Grand Rapids Lions Club Board of Directors voted to donate \$10,000 to help build fund the "Miracle Field", matching a pledge that the Rockford Lions Club made. Our pledge will be paid over 5 years, beginning in 2013. In return, we hope to sponsor the third base dugout with a Grand Rapids Lions Club identification sign. Your Board hopes that our club can have a separate fundraising event(s) specifically to raise these funds. As a backup, we could draw funds from the annual Lions Foundation allocation.
