At the same time, the Lions of Michigan will also offer a Lions Graduate Institute for those who have already attended the Leadership Institute. This is for Lions who want to enhance and better utilize their Lions skills, presentation skills and leadership skills.

In a casual atmosphere in a wooded area on the north shore of Higgins Lake, presenters will conduct sessions in a relaxed, informal setting.
