### **2021 INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE NOW VIRTUAL**

JUNE 25-29 2021 - LOCATION: WHEREVER YOU ARE!

Recently Lions Clubs International sent out this message in regards to the upcoming 2021 International Conference:

"Due to the continuing concerns about the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the board of directors voted to transition the 2021 Montreal Lions Clubs International Convention to a virtual event that will be delivered totally online. This decision was made with the health and safety of our Lions, staff and vendors in mind as limiting international travel and large gatherings is key to global containment strategies.

Here are some important details about the 2021 convention we would like to share with you now:

- Our 2021 convention will be a virtual event that's open to all Lions and Leos around the world.
- The registration fee will be US\$50 until March 31, then US\$75 beginning April 1. The registration fee for Leos will be US\$30 regardless of date. Convention is currently scheduled for June 25-29. Additional event and registration details will be provided soon.
- Lions who are currently registered for convention will receive an email soon with more information about their registration options.
- Executive officer and international director elections will be conducted electronically, and voting procedures will be forthcoming.
- Convention updates and details will be posted here at <u>lcicon.lionsclubs.org</u> as they become available.

This global health pandemic has forced us all to make decisions and changes that place health and safety first. However, we are optimistic that with each new day there is hope, and as Lions, we continue to find new ways to stay connected, safely serve our communities and continue our global mission of service."

OUR GRAND RAPIDS LIONS CLUB HISTORY - MEMBER FOCUS



Name: Carl Schowalter (September 13, 1903 - August 24, 2005) Profession: Owner, Kelly Shirt Company Years as a Lion: 1939-2005

A humble shirt maker, he died at the age of 101, leaving our Endowment Fund \$100,000. It's been 16 years since he left us in 2005, but a lot of us still remember him.

He was married twice for 25 years each and out lived both wives. He had no children. Some of us would pick Carl up at his home on the west side and take him out to lunch. He loved the Schintzelbonk and Big Boys. When ordering coffee, he would ask for a styrofoam cup. When he left, it was always filled with all the sugar and salt packets on the table. Very frugal, but he left over a million dollars to charity. I took him out to lunch one day and asked about our Lions endowment fund. He played hard of hearing and never give me a straight answer. That old fox! What great memories of a good Lion!

#### **Grand Rapids Lions Club Foundation:**

The Grand Rapids Community Foundation (GRCF) manages the Grand Rapids Lions Club Foundation for the Club. Each year GRCF distributes the fund earnings back to our club; usually about 5%. Our board of directors in turn distributes the money to our charities. Recently this has amounted to \$55,000 a year. With each passing year, the amount from this distribution grows and we are able to donate more funds to our key charities and other worthy causes which are consistent with our mission.



Soon after Carl's death in 2005, **Carl's Fund** was developed and ran for several years to receive contributions from Grand Rapids Lions Club members on an annual, sustained giving basis.
