BUILD-A-BED: APRIL 15 9AM-12NOON

Fellow Lions, below is a letter from Lion Brent Spoelstra, Rick Walker and Rick Stevens, covering this incredible need:

On March 7, 2023, our guest speaker at the Lions luncheon was our own District Governor Diane Wehby. Among other things, she spoke to us about a great opportunity to help the children of our Grand Rapids community. A non-profit organization called "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" (SHP) provides single beds and bunk beds for children ages 3-17 who otherwise might be sleeping on the floor.

There is an inspirational video about them on their website, <u>http://www.shpbeds.org</u>

They build the beds from donated lumber, provide donated bedding (mattresses, sheets, blankets, and pillows), and deliver and set up the beds at the recipient's home. SHP enlists help from community organizations like us to accomplish their mission.

There are a number of SHP Chapters in western Michigan that hold "Builds" where volunteers perform tasks turning raw lumber into beds. These "Build" sessions last approximately 3 hours and produce, depending on volunteer turnout, dozens of beds ready for delivery to needy recipients. The tasks do not require special skills. Our Governor, Diane, said that "if (she) could do it anybody can." There will be a number of Builds taking place in the next couple months.

Our Grand Rapids Lions Club has committed to helping this cause.

As such, we are looking for volunteers who are willing to donate several of their weekend hours to construct these beds. All tools are provided. The work is done in an assembly line fashion, so attention to the task is required, lest the process falters. **Our first opportunity to help will be** <u>on Saturday, April 15 from 9:00</u> <u>am to noon</u>. The indoor site is in the greater GR area. The coordinators are looking for 35-40 volunteers from our Lion District. Can our club step up? This is a good opportunity to invite your friends and family (adults) to our club activities. We're looking for 20 or more participants from our club.

Please contact us if you are willing to participate in this project. We will provide more details when they become available. While this project isn't necessarily "vision" related, the community benefits greatly from it. And isn't this what the Lions are about? "We Serve"


EYEGLASS RECYCLING CENTER WORK SESSION APRIL 11:
