We will be assembling Pencil Boxes to give to children. All K-2 students receive tutoring in reading. Students meet one time per week with a volunteer tutor. Many students at the school are not exposed to reading and having one on one time with a tutor helps to improve reading skills and gain confidence with their reading. Volunteers are needed.
