TREASURER'S REPORT

FY 2023 Treasurer's Report

Our year ended June 30, 2023. Since that time, Jeff Kraai has generously shared his time with me to educate me in the historical & ongoing finances of the Club. We have had to make some minor changes to our accounting software and the way we process payments that you may notice. And, since Jeff is no longer receiving payments, the Club's business address is now:

The following is a recap of the financial highlights for 2023:

The General Fund – this is the corporation through which we host our lunches and social events. Dues are billed throughout the year based on a member's status. The fund typically runs small monthly deficits. Our primary revenue is from dues and was around \$29,000 with some other small sources of income. Our primary expense is meals/parking at the U Club and came in at \$10,200. Other costs are dues paid to Lions International/Michigan; wages to the Secretary, Treasurer & Editor; some social events (like the Installation Banquet & Summer Outing) and administrative expenses. The loss for the year was (\$2,012).

The Charities Fund – this is the corporation that sponsors our charitable events & fundraising, such as the Blind Dinner Date (BDD), Drive for Vision (DFV) and the Used Eye Glass program. The BDD netted \$13,200 and the DFV netted \$17,600. We allocate the proceeds from these events to The Association for the Blind & Vision Impaired, Cherry Street Eye Glass Center and the GR Community Foundation.

We have funds held at Grand Rapids Community Foundation. The balance at June 30, 2023 was \$1,117,052, of which approximately \$44,000 is spendable. These funds allow us to make grants to numerous charities. The total amount of donations the GR Lions made for the year from fund-raisers plus the foundation dollars was approximately \$73,000.

DECEMBER 2: HOLIDAY SHOPPING

Volunteers needed for in-person shopping on Saturday, December 2, 2023

Meijer generously donates a \$30 gift card per child within a total limit of \$1500 for the event. The Grand Rapids Lions Club donates \$95 per child (up up \$4750 for 50 children) to set a budget of \$125 per gift card for children to spend on their family members. "Pass the Hat" donations through through collections at Lions luncheons assist in supplementing the cost of having additional children participate. For each \$125 collected, an additional child is able to attend
