Our Grand Rapids Lions Club has been a model of service to our community success for 105 years. This has been accomplished with our dedicated members and our strong club leadership. Each year we elect two new members for our Board of Directors and this year we will be electing a new Vice President.

Directors serve a three year term. There are six Directors and their terms overlap so each year we elect two new ones as two retire from the Board. We also have a Membership Director which is a three year term. The Vice President and President terms are two years. The Vice President assumes the Presidency at the end of their VP term and we elect a new VP. Our club holds six general board meetings a year, all by Zoom, in the comfort of your home or office (or sometimes your parked car). Four executive board meetings a year are also held with the Pres, VP, Secretary, Treasurer and Membership Director only present. Also by Zoom. These meetings are all an hour or less.

These offices start on July 1, 2024 and run their two or three year term. Vice President Kyle Travis is charged with finding candidates for the board and VP positions. PLEASE consider taking the opportunity to fill one of these openings. The only requirement for Vice President is that you have already served on the GR Lions board.
