NOTES FROM OUR PRESIDENT: DR GARY ANDERSON







Every year about this time, you are asked aa meeting to buy some \$10 Sight and Hearing Sweepstakes tickets to support our Lions of Michigan Foundation. You may not realize it but as a Michigan Lion member, you are automatically members of two foundations. Our Lions International Foundation that provides grants for service and disaster relief all the world is probably familiar to most of you.

The second foundation is our Lions of Michigan Foundation helps fill the gaps to cover some health care health costs for those in Michigan that cannot afford it. If a citizen has a medically needed procedure that the person cannot afford what their insurance does not pay, they can request financial help. A local club like ours has to give initial approval of the request. A Foundation trustee then determines if there is true financial need and then contacts the medical provider to see if they can get the medical fees reduced to a more manageable level. Once all is approved, the Foundation pays the bill.

The \$10 sweepstakes tickets are sold throughout the state. The big bonus back to the club that sells the tickets is that if we sell 100 or more tickets, we get \$5.00 back to our Grand Rapids Club for each ticket we sell. This is an easy way to raise \$500 for our charitable fund and to raise \$500 to help those in Grand Rapids that need extra assistance in the sight and hearing deficiency areas. Our club has 5-10 requests a year that we pass onto the Lions of Michigan Foundation for analysis and assistance.

I will have tickets at all of our meetings and of course I can mail them to you if you cannot come to the meetings.

Oh, I forgot to tell you that there are prizes in this sweepstakes. On May 18, 2024 a drawing will be held. **The Grand Prize ticket holder gets \$5,000.** There are 9 more winning tickets drawn, winning \$2,500, \$2,000, \$1,500, \$1,000, \$500, \$400, \$300, \$200, \$100.

If all 100 tickets go quickly, I can get more. Let's see what we can do to help those in need AND maybe have our winning ticket pulled. Call or email me for tickets.


