They decided to build the 2 rooms to the left side of the office out of brick, too. This increased the cost of the project by \$900. They were going to work to save that up but I had some extra donations and then Mark and I supplemented, so I was able to send the funds needed on Wednesday.

They've already started building it!

The right side of the office building that is covered will be enclosed with lumber and will be the work area for the women.

The uncompleted brick building is the drop toilet.

Once again, the Ugandans are incredibly grateful for everything we've done to help them - as am I.
